To foster creativity in the production of craft goods.

To assist in the promotion and sale of such goods made by participating members

Membership of LLCA is open to all crafters in the West of Scotland.

Membership fees: **One time registration fee: £10.00**

Annual membership fee: £30.00.

This covers the period January to December. Members joining part way through the year will pay £2.50 for each month remaining. Membership is renewable each January

The Association strives to establish a framework where local craft businesses can successfully flourish and grow. As a member you can become involved in LLCA organised craft fairs, trade fairs and LLCA board of management meetings.

A regular newsletter is distributed to all members. This covers local craft news and advertises training and social events. Upon joining members are provided with an entry and photograph on the LLCA website. This is currently free of charge.
